Assessing the Risks

As required by the UK Government we have assessed our COVID-19 risks

Our key risks are:

- Wellbeing of our workforce
- Inability to maintain social distancing
- Travelling to work
- Entering the workplace
- Operating in the work environment
- Use of shared/communal spaces including rest rooms, shower rooms, locker rooms
- Allowing visitors/subcontractors onto site
- Use of shared tools
- Receiving deliveries
- The use of vehicles/mobile plant
- Entering client-controlled sites
- Disposing of potentially contaminated waste
- Entering residential properties
- Protecting vulnerable people (CVs and CEVs)
- Protecting vulnerable workers (security & cleaners)

Five steps to safer working together

- ✓ We have carried out a COVID-19 risk assessment and shared the results with the people who work here
- ✓ We have cleaning, handwashing and hygiene procedures in line with guidance
- ✓ We have taken all reasonable steps to help people work from home
- ✓ We have taken all reasonable steps to maintain a 2m distance in the workplace
- ✓ Where people cannot be 2m apart, we have done everything practical to manage transmission risk
